Additional Instructions

- Everyone participating in testing, including testers and assistants, must wear a clean **WHITE** Gi with name and patch.
- All instructors should notify the host school of all students intending to test so that testers, graders and testing space can be provided for in advance. Since there are many testers visiting from out of town it is not feasible for them to come give a test when there are no test candidates for them to test.
- All testing students must be current on annual dues.
- TESTERS should end test as scheduled and clear the floor in preparation for the next test.
- As a courtesy to the testing instructor, please include a copy of a student's written test, if applicable, with the student test form.

PAPERS

- BROWN BELT/ONE BLACK STRIPE send to tester two weeks prior to test. Email address is under name (Brown Belt and above). Also upload paper to the Regional Test event on the Cuong Nhu website.
- TWO BLACK STRIPES as a courtesy to the tester, notify them via writing, phone or email of your intentions to test.

Note: Late papers will receive an automatic one-month probation

Test Procedures

- All test results should be filled out on the current test forms
- All tests are pass or fail with the exception of late papers, not breaking boards or coming to the test late.
- Any student coming to the test more than 10 min late, will receive an automatic 1-month probation.
- All students are required to break boards within the required trials. A student may be afforded one (1) opportunity to re-break boards, at the testers choosing, if that student would pass the test.
